Day 1 Berlin

Make your way to Berlin's Hauptbahnhof and to the Reception Car where your Hotel-train awaits on a reserved platform. The Reception Car is easily recognisable: it's the one with the red carpet. At 2 pm, meet for a welcome cocktail on board the Hotel-train before boarding your coach for a sightseeing tour of Berlin. Highlights include: the Kurfürstendamm, the Reichstag and Charlottenburg Palace; a picture-stop at the monumental Brandenburg Gate; the Victory Column in the Tiergarten Park; Emperor William memorial church; the State Opera House; and Checkpoint Charlie. Return to the Hotel-train where you will have time to change into your evening attire for a formal reception. At 8 pm, you are invited to the Captain's Dinner on a reserved riverboat, where you are personally welcomed by the Train's Captain with a glass of sparkling wine. Here you will be briefed on all aspects of the tour and will meet the staff who will be looking after you during the next 7 days. Enjoy dinner while cruising the Spree River, with Berlin's skyline as a backdrop. Overnight onboard the Hotel-train, travelling to Cologne.

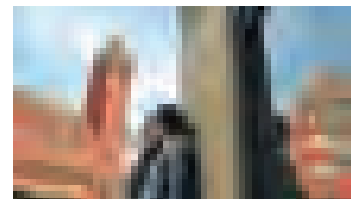
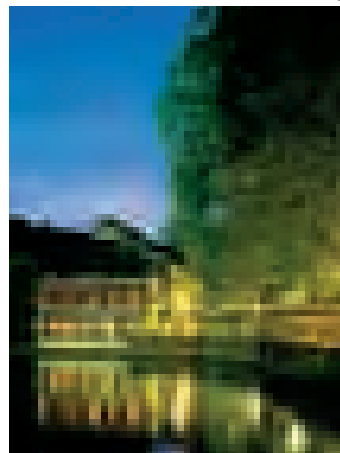
Day 2 Cologne

Enjoy breakfast in the comfort of your Hotel-train cabin. Board a luxury coach and take-in the major attractions of Cologne, the former Roman provincial capital Colonia. Drive past the remnants of the Roman and medieval city wall; the head office of 4711- the famous Eau de Cologne; enjoy the view of the old town of Cologne and the Rhine Garden, from the Rhine embankment in Deutz; visit Cologne Cathedral, one of the biggest in the world and the landmark of the town; and visit a chocolate museum. The afternoon is at leisure. Dinner will be at a local restaurant, within walking distance of your Hotel-train. After dinner you have the chance to enjoy an evening at the Casino (at your own expense). Overnight onboard the Hotel-train, travelling to Offenburg.

Day 3 Offenburg & Strasbourg

Enjoy a delicious breakfast on board before embarking on a tour of Offenburg, the former Imperial Free City dating from 1148, surrounded by vineyards and situated on the river Kinzig. After a short walk through the city, enjoy a drive through the Black Forest. In the afternoon visit Strasbourg, France. Strasbourg, on the border of Germany and France, is a surprisingly cosmopolitan destination, full of the flavours of both countries, hosts France's oldest Christmas market and features a stunning cathedral. The Cathedral is one of Europe's most beautiful examples of gothic architecture. Dinner will be at a restaurant en-route back to Offenburg to overnight aboard the Hotel-train, travelling to Basel.

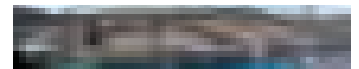

Day 4 Basel

After breakfast on the Hotel-train, board a luxury coach and drive through the inner city of Basel. We will cross the River Rhine several times to give you glimpses of the well-preserved old town while driving past the city gates, university, town hall and a number of museums. The tour of Basel ends with a short walk from the Art Museum to Münsterplatz and on to the terrace high above the River Rhine.



Lucerne

Continue to Lucerne, situated on the Vierwaldstätter See (the Four Forested States Lake, known in English as Lake Lucerne). During a guided tour you will visit the Chapel Bridge, dating from the 14th century, the Water Tower and the Lion Monument. Afterwards, there is time for shopping or an optional boat trip on Lake Lucerne. In the early evening enjoy a Swiss traditional dinner followed by a folklore-show with music, before returning to Basel to overnight aboard the Hotel-train, travelling to Salzburg.

Day 5 Salzburg

After a delicious breakfast in the comfort of your cabin on the Hotel-train, you will then board your coach for a tour that takes you to the major attractions of Salzburg.



Mirabell Gardens, Salzburg

From Mirabell Castle to the old town on the left bank of the River Salzach; past Mozart's birthplace and the Mozarteum, one of the most-famous music schools in the world; cross the Staatsbrücke and enter the heart of the baroque old town, with views of Salzburg Cathedral and the festival precinct; continue to Leopoldskron Castle, scene of the world-famous movie "The Sound of Music"; pass Nonnberg Abbey; and back to Mirabellplatz. In the late afternoon get initiated to the secrets of beer brewing and beer history. Everything you ever wanted to know about beer can be found at Stiegl's "Brauwelt". After a walk through the exhibition, sit back and relax in the Bräustüberl or the Paracelsustube and enjoy a hearty dinner. Overnight on board the Hotel-train, travelling to Dresden.

Day 6 Dresden

Following breakfast on board, your morning city tour of Dresden takes you to the Great Garden, the residential areas of Blasewitz and Loschwitz and Dresden's New Town. Enjoy the ambience of the Old Town alongside the 'Transparent Factory' by Volkswagen, and the River Elbe. In Dresden's Old Town you find examples of baroque architecture like the Dresden Zwinger and the Frauenkirche Church. Take a stroll along the Semper Opera House before continuing by coach to Prague, the "Golden City".

The city tour of Prague includes all the important attractions of Prague's historic city centre and its modern districts, such as the National Opera House, the National Museum, Wenceslas Square, Charles Square and the Castle grounds. Cross the River Vltava to the Jewish Quarter before driving back to the old town where you are free to explore at your leisure. Prague by night is a wonderful sight; more-so as you cruise at a leisurely pace past Prague's major attractions, while enjoying dinner aboard your cruise boat. Late evening return to overnight on the Hotel-train, travelling to Berlin.

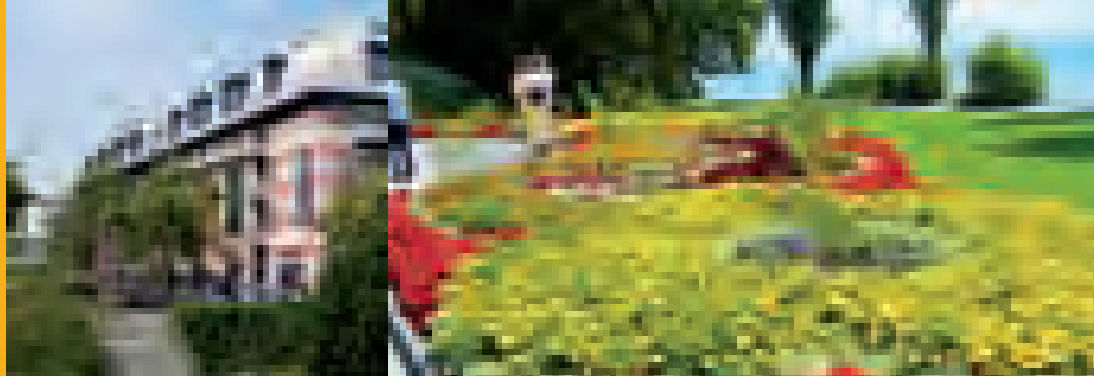

For over three decades the airships were a luxurious and prestigious way of travelling over the Atlantic. At around 270m long and accommodating 72 passengers and 52 crew, they could be compared with the luxurious Atlantic ocean-liners. The modern-day revival of the Zeppelins - named after their inventor German Count Ferdinand von Zeppelin - uses the latest German technology in avionics and non-flammable helium to provide lift. The new Zeppelins are 75m long and have a gondola (passenger car) of 10.7m, three engines allowing a maximum speed of 125km and a flight ceiling of 3000m.

The 300-room palace took nearly 60 years to complete and contains the world's largest ceiling fresco, created by Venetian painter Giovanni Battista Tiepolo, as well as what is often described as the most beautiful staircase in the world. Your visit here will give you a true sense of the history of this region through the European Renaissance. Afterward, visit the town's 200-year-old Christmas Market for one-of-a-kind presents and souvenirs. (BB, L, D)

Day 6 Wertheim

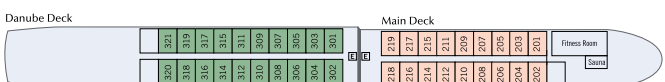
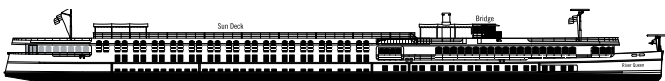
Join your local guide for a walk through the picturesque town of Wertheim, where you can look across the Main River to Bavaria before continuing to the Spitzer Turm (Pointed Tower). Built in the 13th century and once a former prison, the Tower's structure now leans to one side after withstanding over 800 years of flooding. Stop in the historic Wertheim Market Square, lined with half-timbered buildings and shops selling artisan glassworks and Franconian wines in round bottles. Back onboard the ship, enjoy festive carols by some of Wertheim's children, and later listen to a piano recital. (BB, L, D)

On the last full day of your journey, enjoy a panoramic drive amid the high-rises of "Mainhattan." 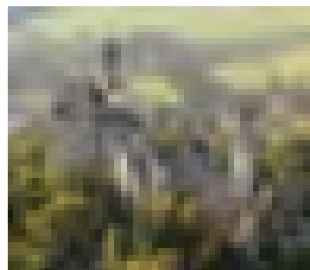
