MONUMENTS OF ROME

Highlights include: Via Veneto, famous for Fellini's movie "La Dolce Vita", Piazza Della Repubblica with its Fountain of the four Najadi (water nymphs); the famous Trevi Fountain and Piazza Navona to see Bernini's Fountain of the Four Rivers; Piazza Colonna with the Column of Marcus Aurelius and the Pantheon, built in the 1st Century b.c. with the widest dome in the world. Continue by coach to the Vatican, passing St. Angel's Castle. Visit Saint-Peter's Square and Saint-Peter's Basilica to view, among others, the Pietà by Michelangelo.

TIVOLI, HADRIAN'S VILLA & VILLA D'ESTE

Highlights include a visit to Tivoli, built on the slopes of the Sabine Hills. Visit Hadrian's Villa, one of the largest and most luxurious country residences, with its magnificent array of palaces, thermal baths, temples, theatres and pools. The Renaissance period Villa d'Este, home of Lucretia Borgia's son, famous for its gardens, fountains, waterfalls and centenary trees.

BORGHESE MUSEUM

The Borghese Gallery, renowned as "the sovereign of all private art collections" has a unique collection of Rome's treasures and delights. Tour the Gallery, with an expert guide viewing the masterpieces that the Borghese Family have amassed in this residence since 1600. Bernini, Raphael, Caravaggio, Tiziano, Domenichino, Correggio, Giorgione are just some of the artists, ranging from ancient Rome up to the Neoclassical style, including Canova's famous nude of Paolina Bonaparte. Continue the tour, through the delightful Borghese Park, the Pincio Terrace, the Pincio promenade and the Spanish Steps. The final point will be Piazza di Spagna.

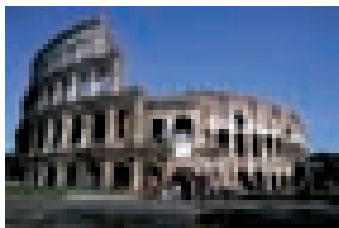

ROME OF THE CEASARS

Visit Piazza Venezia, where you will see the memorial to Victor Emanuel II, the first King of United Italy. The tour will then proceed to the Roman Forum, the old centre of the Imperial City, where the Senate House, the basilicas and the temples of the major gods are located. After walking down the Via Sacra and passing by the Arch of Titus, you will visit the Coliseum, surrounded by impressive monuments such as the ruins of the Arch of Constantine the Great. The last stop on your tour will be the 5th-century Christian Basilica of St. Peter in Chains, where you will see the world famous Statue of Moses by Michelangelo.

Note: From Nov 1 to Mar 31, due to the earlier winter closing time of the Roman Forum, the visit and the commentary will operate from the hilltop of the Capitol, without missing the walk alongside the Imperial Forums of Nerva, Augustus, Trajan and Caesar.

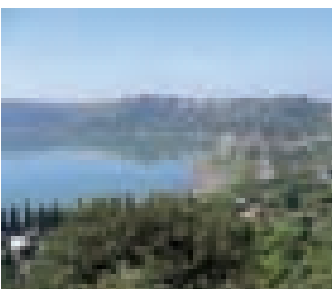

CHRISTIAN ROME

Passing by Piazza Barberini with the Triton Fountain by Bernini, reach St. Mary-Major a beautiful Basilica dedicated to Mary, Mother of Christ. Continue to St. John's-in-Lateran cathedral and first Papal residence with masterpieces from Middle Ages to Baroque. Stop at the Holy Stairs. Through the first part of the Appian Way, with a view at the Domine Quo Vadis Chapel, reach the Catacombs, the ancient underground Cemeteries and expression of faith of the early Christians. The tour ends with a view of Caracalla Thermal Baths.

ROMAN COUNTRYSIDE

Discover the surroundings of Rome with the old medieval towns and its volcanic lakes, giving you the opportunity to relax for few hours. Along the Caracalla Baths and the Appian Way reach Castelgandolfo, summer residence of the Pope, overlooking one of the deepest volcanic lakes. Continue to Albano former Albalonga where Rome founders originated from; Ariccia with a breathtaking bridge, Genzano reputed for its flower carnival, Nemi the town of wild strawberries overlooking an enchanting lake "Mirror of God Diana". Travel along the Via dei Laghi, Rocca di Papa, Grottaferrata, Frascati, where you will have a chance to sit down to taste its wine

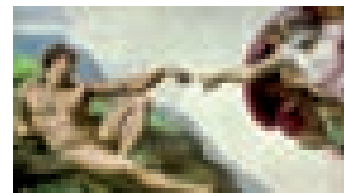

ANCIENT OSTIA

Only 30 minutes away from the Capital lies an amazing archeological site - the impressive excavations of Ancient Ostia. This city harbour was founded by ancient Romans, at the mouth of the Tiber. With remains better preserved than in Rome itself Ostia offers an extraordinary testimonial of Roman civilisation in its evolution. By walking through the ancient roads you will plunge straight into the past of a refined and dynamic city. Admire the ruins of public buildings, like temples, theatres, fora or basilicas as well as of the private ones, like houses, shops, inns and workshops. Particularly attractive are the famous mosaics of the 12 thermal baths and of the various harbour offices.

FLORENCE DAY TOUR

Leaving Rome the coach travels North through three of the most beautiful Italian regions: Latium, Umbria and Tuscany. Arrive in Florence at about 11.30 am and go to Piazzale Michelangelo, to admire a fantastic view of the city and the famous Ponte Vecchio. Continue to the historical centre for free time at leisure. After lunch at a local restaurant, take a guided visit on foot: Santa Croce Square with the Church, where Michelangelo and Galileo are buried. Stop at a leather factory and visit the Museum of Accademia, with the famous Statue of David by Michelangelo. The walk continues to Piazza della Signoria, the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore where you will see the Dome by Brunelleschi, the Baptistery and Giotto's Belltower. Return to Rome with arrival at about 9.00 pm.

ASSISI, PERUGIA

Crossing the region of Umbria we reach Assisi. Visit the Church of Santa Chiara where St. Francis was born. Walking through the narrow streets to reach Piazza del Comune with the Palazzo dei Priori, The Palazzo del Popolo and the Temple of Minerva. Continue to the Basilica of St. Francis with masterpieces by Giotto and Cimabue. After lunch in a local restaurant, continue by bus to the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, place where St. Francis lived and died, with visit to the Porziuncola Chapel. Proceed to Perugia, the famous art city renowned for its University. Stop in Piazza 4 November, the heart of the historical centre for free time at leisure. Return to Rome at about 5p.m. with arrival at about 7.30 p.m.

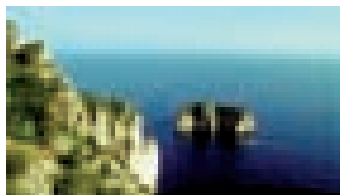

NAPLES CAPRI ANACAPRI

Leave Rome southwards along the Autostrada del Sole. Arrival in Naples and embark to the Island of Capri, the most famous in the Mediterranean. Upon arrival, weather permitting, visit the Blue Grotto, a miracle of equilibrium among water, light and reflections of wonderful seafloors. Return to Marina Grande and proceed by minibuses to Anacapri, for lunch at a restaurant. Free time for shopping and then back to Marina Grande to embark the boat to Naples. Return to Rome at about 8.30 pm.

NAPLES - POMPEII

Leave Rome along the Autostrada del Sole. Halfway to Naples, you will see the Abbey of Montecassino, completely rebuilt after the total destruction in World War II. Continue on through fertile countryside surrounding Naples. After a short sightseeing, on the way to Pompeii stop for a visit to an ancient cameo and coral factory in Torre del Greco. Then on to Pompeii for lunch and then to visit of the excavations of the preserved areas in the city. The 79AD Mt. Vesuvius eruption completely destroyed Pompeii and Herculaneum. Its ashes, gases and hot clouds claimed numerous lives yet in the process preserved the ancient environment giving a snapshot of Roman society at its height. At the end of the visit continue to Rome with arrival at about 8.30 pm.

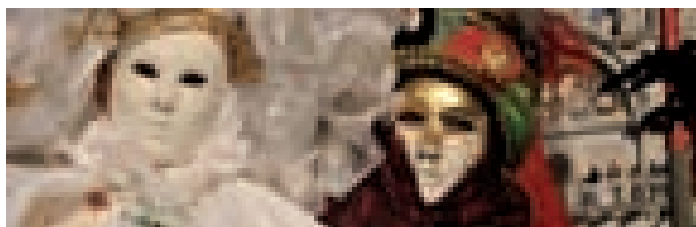

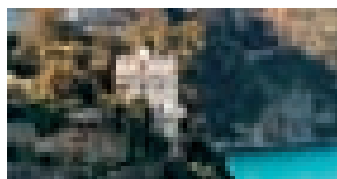

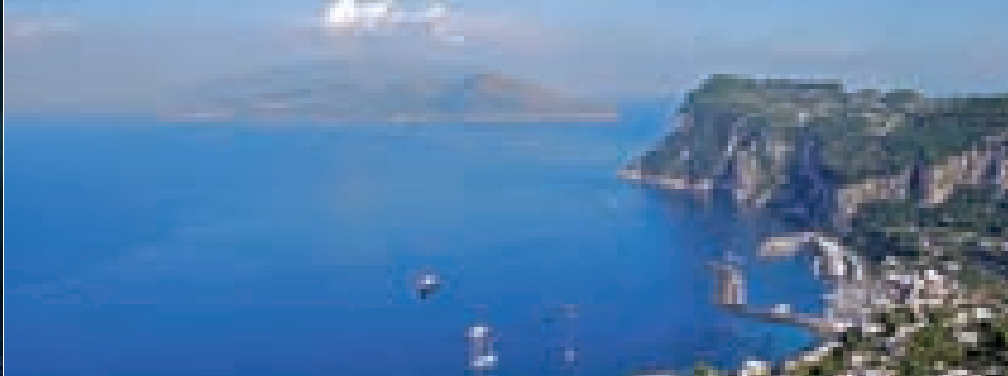
NAPLES

To holiday in Naples is to visit the real Italy, without the frills, where dust and dirt somehow add to the flavour of this city which bubbles with life and colourful characters like the lava below its surface on the convergence of seismic faults. Most travel to Naples in order to visit the nearby well-preserved ruins of Pompeii and Herculaneum, destroyed in an eruption of Mount Vesuvius, which stands sentinel over the city.



CAPRI, a small Italian island situated 5 km from the mainland in the Bay of Naples, a celebrated beauty spot and coastal resort since the days of the Roman Republic until now. It is also part of Campania.

Capri, known in Greek mythology as the isle of the sirens, was a favored resort of the Roman emperors. Most notoriously, the emperor Tiberius had his villa on the island. Those who displeased the emperor were flung to their deaths from the cliffs.

MUST-SEE PLACES OF MILAN



1. Duomo

Duomo is the cathedral church of Milan. The cathedral is significant in the spread of the Christian faith, for its role in the establishment of Catholic traditions of worship, its outstanding musical heritage and the splendour of its Gothic architecture. Built from the late 14th well into the 19th century, the Duomo di Milano is one of the world's largest churches, being second in size within Italy only to Saint Peter's Basilica in Rome, and the second largest Gothic cathedral in the world, after the Cathedral of Seville in Spain. The interior height of its central nave is surpassed only by the choir of the incomplete Beauvais Cathedral in France.

2. La Scala

The La Scala is one of the world's most famous opera houses. The theatre was opened on 3 August 1778, under the name Nuovo Regio Ducal Teatro alla Scala with Salieri's *Europa Riconosciuta*. La Scala hosted the prima (first production) of many famous operas, and had a special relationship with Giuseppe Verdi.

3. Castello Sforzesco

The Castello Sforzesco is an imposing fortress built by the noble families of the Visconti and the Sforza, seat of one of the most magnificent courts of Italian Renaissance. It now houses several of the city's museum gallery collections.

4. Santa Maria delle Grazie

The church of Santa Maria delle Grazie, which houses one of the most famous paintings of Leonardo da Vinci, *The Last Supper*.



Rocella Jazz Festival, Calabria

The Rocella Jazz Festival is one of the most important music festivals in Southern Italy. The festival itself takes place over one week in August each year in the small village of Rocella Ionica, located between Reggio Calabria and Crotona (Calabria). Lovers of jazz have the chance to enjoy an interesting music scene. The sophisticated concerts can also be combined with several seminars, which are usually held throughout the week. The seminars include photography, music lessons, music therapy and dance. The castle, theatre and town auditorium make an exquisite backdrop for the festival.

How to reach Rocella Ionica

Rocella Ionica is located 105 kms from Reggio di Calabria Airport. From there you can take the train towards Rocella Ionica. Another option is getting there by car. Just take the motorway S. S. Jonica 106 from Reggio di Calabria to Rocella Ionica.

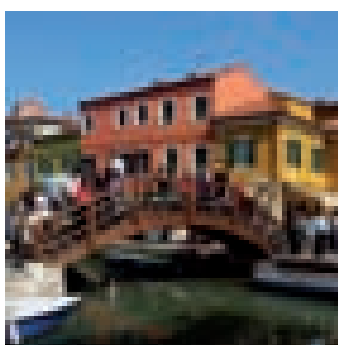
CITY TOUR ON FOOT
