### THE GREAT TOUR OF ZURICH

Starting with a guided city tour of Zurich, you will see the Fraumünster Church, historical Limmatquai and the University District. Following the Höhenstrasse which offer views of the Alps, drive to Rapperswil, the 'City of Roses'. This charming town offers many attractions including the Rose Gardens, the Castle, the Deer Park on the Lindenhof and the Old Town. Afterwards, enjoy a 2-hour unescorted cruise on the Lake of Zurich. Between Nov-Mar there are no boats operating, so you return to Zurich by modern 'Gold Coast Express' train along the road that follows the lake-shore.

### ZURICH COMBO TOUR

The perfect combination - an informative city tour of Zurich and a train trip up to 'Top of Zurich', the Ütliberg, Zurich's highest vantage point. A comprehensive 2-hour city-tour on board the unique 'Classic Trolley' awaits you. Following the city tour enjoy a pleasant independent train trip to Ütliberg - Top of Zurich. At 871 metres above sea level, Ütliberg towers over the roofs of Zurich. From the top of the summit's 30m viewing tower, your altitude is increased to 900m.

### MT. PILATUS THE DRAGON MOUNTAIN

A guided coach ride takes you to Kriens, your starting point for the Golden Round Trip. Travel independently by panorama gondola and aerial cableway to the summit of Mount Pilatus. Enjoy the ride in the new aerial cable car 'Dragon Ride' which gives passengers the impression of flying thanks to their cockpit-like design and large windows. An impressive panorama of 73 Alpine peaks and countless lakes awaits you on Pilatus Kulm, some 2132 metres above sea level. A ride on the world's steepest cogwheel railway then takes you down to Alpnachstad, where you enjoy a 1 ¼ hour cruise to Lucerne. Here you have some leisure time before meeting your guide and returning to Zurich by coach.

Winter period: Cogwheel railway and boat not operating - both up and down by cableway. You will receive a lunch voucher valid at the restaurants at Mt. Pilatus.

### LUCERNE FOLKLORE TOUR

This excursion takes you to the city of Lucerne. After a short tour of the city, proceed to an Old Town restaurant where traditional Swiss dishes will be served. Starting with a cheese fondue, followed by a hearty bratwurst (which is a veal sausage), and rösti-potatoes. Later-on dessert is served. During lunch you will be entertained with yodelling, singing, Alphorn-blowing and flag-throwing - Swiss Folklore at it's best! The afternoon is yours for exploring Lucerne (Old Town, Chapel Bridge, lakeside promenade, etc.). Return journey by bus to Zurich with the tour guide in the late afternoon.

### JUNGFRAUJOCH - TOP OF EUROPE - FROM ZURICH

Tour the Jungfrau Joch - Top of Europe at 3,454 m, and the magnificent mountain world of the Bernese Oberland. From Lauterbrunnen board the cogwheel train to Jungfrau Joch - Europe's highest railway station. Enjoy the world of eternal snow and ice. Visit the Ice Palace, experience the panoramic view from the Sphinx Observation Terrace overlooking the Aletsch Glacier (Europe's longest glacier) and the snow-capped peaks of the neighbouring countries. Return to Zurich via Grindelwald, arriving at approx 8 pm.
