APPENZELL

This village is situated in a landscape of rolling hills. The region is known for its rural customs and traditions such as the ceremonial descent of the cattle in autumn and cultural events such as folk music and rustic dances, as well as hiking tours in the Alpstein region. This car-free village is dotted with pretty lanes and a myriad of small stores and boutiques. The facades of the buildings are decorated with colourful frescoes.

EVENTS IN AND AROUND APPENZELL

URNÄSCH ALPINE PROCESSION

Every September, farmer families that live on the alps dress in traditional festive costume and move with their cattle back to the valley. The procession walks for hours descending into the valley, and is received by an enthusiastic audience in Urnäsch. The alpine procession is a large festival that enables ancient traditions to come to life again.



BRIENZ is located on eastern-end of Lake Brienz. This village is the starting point for excursions to the Bernese Oberland and the Ballenberg Open-air Museum. Brienz has a long tradition in wood processing and today still has a school for carving and violin-making.

KLOSTERS

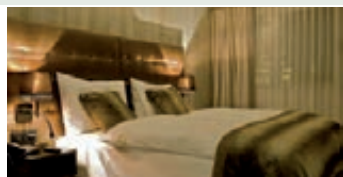
Canton of Graubünden, 1200 m

KLOSTERS | CHESA GRISCHUNA ★★★

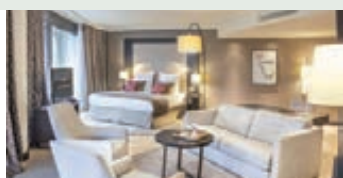
Historic Chalet hotel with all modern conveniences including free Wi-fi. Decorated in the Grisons style decorated with local pinewood panelling.

DAVOS | SUNSTAR ALPINE HOTEL DAVOS ★★★★★

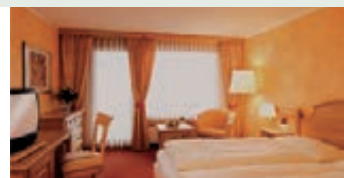
Recently renovated, this hotel is located 1 km from the train station. The rooms and suites are equipped with a private bathroom, satellite TV and minibar.
